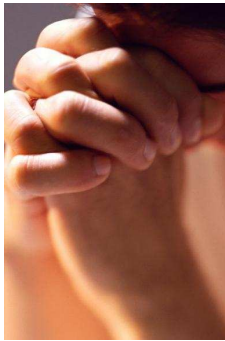


## PRAYER VIGIL
